**The Netherlands were again recognized for “Eat Love” by Marije Vogelzang (B.I.S.), which is one of the “Two Best in the World for Cookbook Design” this year. The author is very talented, with an excellent book with innovative concepts.**

**The wine book “Chateauneuf-du-Pape” by Harry Karis (Kavino) was honoured in Paris as one of the “Two Best in the World” about French wines. The other book was the French book by Michel Chapoutier. The Dutch book received a “Special Award” for its brilliant research and achievement.**
